

Montana Preschool Teacher Education Hybrid Class

Course Description: This course has been specifically developed for individuals who teach preschool-age children in early childhood settings. Through course assignments and application of practices in current early childhood settings, participants explore the broad base of knowledge and skills around preschool education. Each participant examines their own practice in the context of the course content, and develops the core principles which guides their work. The knowledge and skills developed during course activities strengthen participants' abilities to support the healthy growth and development of every child.

This course has been developed as a hybrid course with a combination of face-to-face and distance components. There will be 3 face-to-face classes, weekly conference calls and an online platform to use for discussions. College credit will be available for this class through The University of Montana Western.
